The Global African Diaspora Kingdom (GADK), a non-profit organization established to foster a united global Africa committed to the development and advancement of Africa and her diaspora, is pleased to announce the Reconnection Tour of South Africa to Johannesburg, Durban KwaZulu-Natal and Cape Town in 2026 (dates to be announced), in collaboration with AIDO Network International. The GADK in partnership with AIDO is uniquely placed to facilitate reconnection of diasporan Africans to the motherland Africa, having successfully delivered four Journeys of Reconnection to Kenya, Uganda, Nigeria and Ghana from 2021 – 2025. The Reconnection Journeys build on the global momentum for reparatory justice inspired by the CARICOM Reparations Commission's advocacy since 2013. The GADK recognises the need for psychological healing, cultural and spiritual reconnection of Africans in the diaspora, having been forcefully separated from the African continent through the brutal system of capture, trafficking and enslavement, perpetrated by Europeans for over 300 years. The separation caused a traumatic loss of language, community, culture, spirituality, names and the important tradition of royalty.

The Reconnection Tour of South Africa promises an inspiring spiritual and cultural experience with a pilgrimage through South Africa's rich and poignant history, visiting the historic places of memory and traditional South African kingdoms of a proud and resilient people. From historical Soweto to the vibrancy of Zulu culture; from the top of Table Mountain to the Cape Point tip of Africa, and paying respect at the famous Robben Island prison where Madiba Nelson Mandela was unjustly held for 27 years; this is a once in a lifetime experience not to be missed!
